Livingston County Clerk Kristy Masching has announced preparations for the November 6, 2012 General Election.

The clerk's office will be open Saturday, October 6th, from 9:00 a.m. to noon, for voter registration, with absentee voting available by mail and in the clerk's office starting September 27th.

The registration deadline for the November 6th General Election is Tuesday, October 9, 2012 which includes new registrations as well as changes of address or name. "Voters often don't realize they are required to notify the county clerk's office each time they move, even if the move is across the street or in the same apartment building," said Masching.

A change of address can be done by mail, using the back of the voter registration card, or by any other form of written notification. A name change requires a new registration card. In addition to registering in person at the county clerk's office, there are numerous deputy registrars located throughout the county.

The temporary address for the county clerk's office is 103 N. Oak, Pontiac, 61764.
